6:30 P.M. PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Masino opened the Public Hearing at 6:32 P.M. City Manager, Hardin Watkins, read the procedures for public meetings for the record.

1. RZ-2006-013 - Applicant: OPUS South Corporation. Owner: Opus South Corporation/Falcon Nest I, LTD. Applicant requests rezoning from M-1, C-2, C-3, and O-I to PMUD to allow for a multiple use project including commercial/retail, offices, multi-family, townhomes, and single family detached uses. Site is located in Land Lots 152 and 169 of the 7th District on south west side of Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road and north Burnette Road and contains approximately 148.32 acres. [P2]

Marty Allen stated Council postponed this rezoning case last month at the applicants' request. The applicant is still working on revisions to the plan due to staff conditions and information recently received that there is a Georgia DOT project, which will impact the site. To date, no plan revisions have been submitted to the Planning Department. The applicant was not present and there was no audience participation.

2. RZ-2006-016 - Applicant/Owner: Suwanee Junction, LLC. Applicant requests rezoning from PMUD to PMUD (change of conditions) to allow for a modification to the approved concept plan. Site is located in Land Lots 251 and 252 of the 7th District along Suwanee Dam Road and contains approximately 112.69 acres.

Marty Allen stated the applicant has requested withdrawal of this rezoning case. Staff recommended denial of the case. The Planning Commission voted to recommend denial. Normal procedure is that the City gives a response when the applicant has gone through the process. The applicant was not present and there was no audience participation.

1. Call To Order

Mayor Masino called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M.

2. Announcements

- The City of Suwanee is seeking input as it creates an Alternative Transportation Master Plan that will utilize sidewalk, greenway, and bike path systems to connect Suwanee locations both within the City limits and in a regional context. An open house is scheduled for Thursday, October 26 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at North Gwinnett High School to allow citizens to provide input.
- On Friday, October 27 the City will show a Halloween Movie at Town Center Park. The festivities will begin at 7:00 p.m. and at dusk The (Original) Mummy will be shown with subtitles. The soundtrack will be played live by The Mustangs.
- On Saturday, October 28, the fun moves to Suwanee Creek Park for Trek or Treat from 11:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Activities include a costume parade and contest, fall festival and carnival games, free hot dogs while supplies last, music, and, of course, trek or treating along the Suwanee Creek Greenway.

 - ✓ 3CMA: Lynne DeWilde reported back from the City County Communications and Marketing Association (3CMA) Convention in Dallas, TX with good news. We've

- finally won a <u>Savvy Award</u> (the top one in the US!). We won for Art on a Limb in the "<u>Most Creative Activity with Least Dollars Spent</u>" category. Finalists in the category represented cities with populations up to 106,000 citizens.
- ✓ 3CMA: Art on a Limb also won a Silver Circle Award (second place in the US) in the <u>Best Use of a Promotional Item</u> category. The winner was Tallahassee, FL, and the category included cities with up to 350,000 citizens.
- ✓ 3CMA: Our newsletter, CrossRoads, won an <u>Award of Excellence</u> (third place in the US) in the <u>External Newsletter</u> category. Decatur, GA won the Savvy and Golden, CO, took the Silver Circle. Population in our category was up to 46,000 citizens.
