



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I apply to the Suwanee Farmers Market for just one week?

A. Preference is given to full season commitments. We do have vendors who alternate every other week. We do not add vendors mid-season.

Q. I am a baker with a state cottage license. May I apply?

A. We do not allow bakers on a cottage license in the Suwanee Farmers Market. We only allow goods baked in a commercial kitchen that is inspected by a county health department.

Q. I make farmer-themed crafts, may I apply?

A. Our rules and guidelines are only for consumable products (edible or usable), not arts and crafts. We have a limited amount of space and do not have room for arts and crafts. Consider applying to Suwanee Fest instead.

Q. You already have a (coffee/meat/soap/bread) vendor, but can I still apply?

A. We try to not duplicate vendors when possible, with the exception of produce; after all, it is a farmers market!

Q. I'd love to have a booth to promote my business or non-profit, may I apply?

A. Market rules and guidelines do not allow for business booths or non-profit booths, only consumable goods. Space is limited and we want as many consumable and yummy vendors as possible.
